Note this indenture witnesses as follows:-

1. That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the founder has set apart and handed over to the trustee, a sum of **Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupee One Lakh Only)** hereinafter called the 'CORPUS FUND' which expression shall include cash and any other property or investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time or which may be acquired by the trustee(s) or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents, and the trustee(s) shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreement and declarations hereinafter contained.
2. That the name of the trust shall be **UMA CHANDRA SOCIAL WELFARE AND EDUCATIONAL TRUST** and its office shall, for the presents, be situated at Alkapuri (Damarla), P.O. - Anisabad, Thana-Gardanibagh, Patna-800002 and/or at such other place or places as the trustee(s) may decide from time to time.

**4. That the objects for which this trust is established are:-**

- (a) To promote welfare, social cultural, charitable, occupational welfare, health education, humanitarian, and relief activities that will protect, safeguard, improve the quality and raise the standard of human life, particularly economically weaker sections of the society, irrespective of caste creed, race colour, sex or religion so that they may lead healthy, happy contented and dignified life.
- (b) To promote and advocate Human Rights and Fundamental Freedom for all without any discrimination of race, religion, caste, color, sex and language.
- (c) To undertake projects and programmes for the management of solid and liquid waste.

- (d) To support, establish, run, takeover or manage and maintain schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of like nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general, with an object to provide sound pre-primary, primary, middle, secondary, senior secondary and higher education/ Medical and other technical education to children by seeking recognition.
- (e) To establish, maintain and run student-ships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends/medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.
- (f) To undertake, organize, conduct and facilitate, Courses, conference, lecture, research and education on various aspects and of science, technology, trust and other fields.
- (g) To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash to hospitals, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public.
- (h) To organize and take up Health, Educational and Welfare programs for needy on priority basis.
- (i) To arrange and manage the training institutions in Education, Health, Computer, Fine Arts, Crafts, Music, Dancing, Painting, Modeling, Yoga, Physical Education and in other professional training subjects.
- (j) To engage, employ or hire appropriate staff, workers, experts and other professionals, managers and agents for the work and furtherance of the aims and objects of the trust and to pay their wages, salaries, stipends or fees.
- (k) To promote literacy, culture and other social activities by awareness programmes, Adult Education Classes, Lectures, Competitions, Symposiums, Cultural Programs, Press Conferences and Seminars.
- (l) To purchase/acquire the land and/or the building in the name of the Trust and make construction thereupon.
- (m) To promote, establish support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.

- (n) To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and/or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, Library, dharamsalas, and rest house for use by public in general.
- (o) To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help of the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows, kids and aged persons.
- (p) To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disable or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
- (q) To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earthquake, flood, fire, pestilence, etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, establishments or persons engaged in such relief work.
- (r) To grant aid or render assistance to other public charitable and welfare trust or institutions.
- (s) To support, establish, run, takeover or manage and maintain Institutions, Firms, Companies, Foundations, Trusts, NGO's which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Trust.
- (t) To provide support in, legal, educational and medical aid to the needy without any discrimination of race, religion, caste, color, sex and language.
- (u) To do such other things/acts/activities which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Trust.

Without prejudice to the generality of the above objects and for effectively carrying out the same the Trustee(s) shall have full right to receive, hold and possess any property including securities of any kind and to construct and maintain any building, to manage transfer or otherwise dispose of or deal in any property of the Trust and to enter into any contract for or in connection with the purposes of the Trust to raise money and funds for the benefit of the employees of the Trust and to accept the management of any other trust or endowment in which this Trust may be interested. The Trustee(s) shall have also the right to frame rules and byelaws under its construction.

5. The founder shall also be one of the Trustees. The founder and the first Trustee during their lifetimes may nominate Co-Trustee(s) by the majority of the Trustee members.
- If any of the Trustees becomes bankrupt or found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude or become insolvent or

resigns from his post or otherwise incapacitated physically, the remaining Trustees with the consent of the founder so long as he is alive shall substitute on his behalf by the majority of the Trustees.

7. In case there is a difference of opinion between the Trustees, the decision of the majority of the Trustees relating to the trust shall be binding and effectual and shall be carried out.
8. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contributions from time to time.
9. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in para 3 hereinabove.
10. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
11. The trustees shall in no case be liable for any loss to the Trust estate unless the Trustees are guilty of fraud.
12. That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the following powers:
  - (a) To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscriptions in cash or in kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions and loan also may be taken from the founder or the Trustees with interest which shall not exceed the prevailing Bank rate.
  - (b) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust Fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
  - (c) To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investments for the time being.
  - (d) To invest the Trust Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Trustees.
  - (e) To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
  - (f) To sell, dispose off, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
  - (g) To let out demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
  - (h) To open account in the name of the Trust, Trustees and/or institutions run/conducted by the Trust with a Bank or Banks,

to operate such account and to give such instruction to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the Trustees.

- (i) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
- (j) To Engage constituted attorneys or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested on them under these presents and from time to time remove such attorney or agents and to appoint other or others in his or their place.
- (k) To engage or make provision for the engagement of any person (including all or any of the trustees and committees or administrator or managing trustee or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subject to such terms and conditions subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustee may prescribe and also to engage or provide for the engagement of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustee may from time to time think fit.
- (l) To engage, employ or hire appropriate staff, workers, legal experts and other professionals, authority-managers and agents for the work and furtherance of the aims and objects of the Trust and to pay their wages, salaries, stipends or fees.
- (m) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- (n) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- (o) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (p) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustee may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.

- (q) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institutions, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- (r) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (s) To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (t) To apply to Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Department, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- (u) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association, or institution with similar objects.
- (v) To establish, promote, manage, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organizing or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
- (w) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.



To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the Trust, Societies, Institutions or Associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.

- (y) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the Trust, Societies, Institutions or Associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- (z) To transfer and hand over the Trust to any other Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization on such terms and conditions as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the Society, Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization with the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modifications as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the trust Fund. The trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharged from the Trust hereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.
13. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
14. The Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
15. The number of the Trustees shall not be less than three including the Founder and more than seven. If the number of the Trustees shall fall below three, the Trustees shall not, except for the purposes of filling any vacancy, act so long number is below the said minimum.
16. The Trustees shall be empowered to induct new Trustees as per mutual consent and consider proper within the number mentioned above. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either: (i) if he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or (ii) if he is requested to resign by 3/4<sup>th</sup> or as near thereto as possible of the remaining Trustees.
17. Every Trustee shall be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
18. The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of the Trustees, in the absence of such regulations :-
- (a) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) The Trustees will decide all matters mutually.

- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of  $2/3^{\text{rd}}$  of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of the Trustees.
19. The Trustee shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
20. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March every year.
21. The Trust and the Trust Fund shall be and irrevocable for all times.
22. The office of the Trust shall be situated at Patna unless changed by the Trustees by  $2/3^{\text{rd}}$  majority.
23. It is expressly declared that no part of accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.

**24. QUORUM**

The Quorum of the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall not be less than two Trustees, out of which at least one must be a Founder Trustee.

**25. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

- (a) The Trust may receive donations of money and/or properties, which when received shall be at the absolute disposal of the Trust.
- (b) The trustees shall invest the properties and money of the Trust in such manner as prescribed under Section 11 of the Income Tax Act-1961, and other statutory laws, as applicable.
- (c) The Trustees may open and operate current or saving deposit accounts or other accounts with any Nationalized, Scheduled Bank, Co-Operative Banks, Post Office, Private Bank and by resolution, and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of trustee or by an agent appointed by trustees.
- (d) The Board may, by resolution, extend the activities of the Trust or undertake any work in furtherance of the main objects of the Trust.

- (e) In any resolution to be passed relating to the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the Two-Third majority shall prevail. It shall be competent, however, for the Trustees to decide matters by circulation.
- (f) Proper books of accounts shall be maintained by the Trust and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the Board of Trustees, from time to time.
- (g) The trustees shall do such other lawful things or acts as are incidental to carrying out the management and administration of the Trust.
- (h) The Trustees shall maintain the Minutes Book of the Trust, in which the proceedings of all meetings of the Trustees shall be recorded and the Chairperson of each meeting shall sign the same.
- (i) The Trustees may frame rules and regulations concerning the role, responsibilities and duties of each trustee, and may establish committees, Sub-Committees or advisory groups and the mode of conducting any matter connected with the administration of the Trust and its management.
- (j) The Board of Trustees shall constitute a governing Council for each of the institutions run by the Trust in Accordance with the rules for the time being in force. The function of such governing council shall be only advisory on matters relating to organization, management and administration of the Institution.

#### 26. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS

The Managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee, if so authorised by the Board of trustees, shall have the custody of all documents, deed of title, etc relating to the Trust properties and investments, the books of account and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.

#### 27. IRREVOCABILITY

It is declared that the Trust setup under this deed of Declaration is irrevocable, and if the Trust fails or for any reason, in the opinion of the Trustees, the net assets of the Trust, both movable and immovable, shall be handed over to any other body having the same or similar objects, as decided by the Two-third majority of the Trustees at that time.

#### 28. AMENDMENTS

The rules and regulations of the Trust shall be amended by a Two-Third majority of the Trustees.
